1. It is more blessed to give than to receive. (**Acts 20:35**)
Question: How have you found this statement to be true in your life?
2. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. (**Matthew 6:21**)
Question: What are some of your treasures?
3. Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life. (**1 Timothy 6:17-19**)
Question: Do you consider yourself rich? Why or why not?
Question: What do you do when you are tempted to put your hope in wealth?
4. “Money is a tool, a test, and a testimony.”—Ron Blue
 - a. A **tool** to accomplish God’s purposes.
 - b. A **test** to see if we are going to be faithful.
 - c. A **testimony** because it gives us an opportunity to show the world through our generosity how generous God has been to us.
 - d. **Discussion Question:** How has this statement by Ron Blue played out in your life?
5. Pastor Dustin said “Take one step toward generosity.”
Question: What is going to be your one step toward generosity this week?
6. The rich rule over the poor, and the borrower is slave to the lender. (**Proverbs 22:7**)
Question: What is one step you can take to get out of debt?
7. Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, “Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.” (**Hebrews 13:5**)
Question: How content are you with what you have?
8. “And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up. Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.” (**Deuteronomy 6:6-9 NLT**)
Question: If you have children, What are you doing to teach your kids about money?
9. Do not despise these small beginnings. For the Lord rejoices to see the work begin (**Zechariah 4:10**)
Question: How can this verse encourage you to begin a lifestyle of generosity?
10. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. (**2 Corinthians 9:7**)
Question: Pastor Dustin encouraged us to talk to God about doing something by talking to God, take some time to talk to God about what he would have you to do.
